

## Citing Sources Using Noodle Tools

1. Go to Utah's Online Library at <https://onlinelibrary.uen.org>. If you are at school, you should be able to get right in. If you are at home, you need the login information. Login Name: \_\_\_\_\_ Password: \_\_\_\_\_
2. Go to the Reference Collection Section and click on Noodle Tools found on the right-hand side of the screen.
3. Click on the register button located on the bottom left-hand side of the screen.
4. For your new user registration, make sure that you click on "An account linked to a school/library subscription or trial. Then, click on "I am a student or library patron." For school location, find Nebo School District: Mapleton Jr. High. Type in the year of your expected graduation \_\_\_\_\_. Then, type in a username and password (consider using your school username and password so you don't forget.) It will also ask you to include your initials and last four digits of your phone number for easy retrieval of forgotten passwords or usernames. Click on register.
5. Once in Noodle Tools, click on the green New Projects button found at the top left of your screen. Type in 8<sup>th</sup> Grade English Informational Essay as the project title. Click on "MLA" as the citation style, and click on "starter" as the citation level.
6. Now, at the top of your screen click on Sources; then, click on Create New Citation. Click on website and webpage. Then, type in the website URL, date you found the information, and any other information that you have about the source. Then, click on save.
7. Your sources will show up under the new project you created. You can either copy and paste the source at the end of your essay or you can print/export the sources to your Google Docs to attach later to your essay.
